

YIG/LIG WINTER 2024 INDOOR LEAGUE PLAY

(Rules are subject to change depending upon participation)

1) **10 Week League + Playoffs (January 7th, 2024 – March 17th, 2024)**

- a. **Cost:** \$325/new players, \$300/returning players
- b. 2 person teams comprised of men, women, or juniors.
- c. 9 Holes
- d. Stroke / Match Play
- e. **HANDICAPS –Starting handicaps will be determined based on your practice round results. Practice Rounds can be played anytime between December 4th, 2023 - January 7th, 2024.** You may use this time to get familiar to the simulator software and set your starting handicap for the league. Then once scores are recorded during weeks 1-12, the match play weeks, we will calculate handicaps weekly using a “rolling” method (take every score to par, add them up, then average them) and round down (Ex. Rd 1 - +7, Rd 2 - +5, Rd. 3 - +3, your handicap would be a 5)
 - i. **Max Handicap (Men - 18, Women – 20)**
 - ii. **Min. Handicap (Men – 0, Women – 0)**

2) **LEAGUE RULES**

- a. Following Scoring/Point System will be used:
 - i. **Hole Win** (1pt)
 - ii. **Hole Halved** (1/2pt)
 - iii. **Hole Loss** (0pt)
 - iv. **Match Win** (1pt)
- b. 10 points per individual match with 9 points for the 9 holes and the bonus 10th point in each individual match will go to the person with the low net score, 20 total team points available per team match.
- c. The top 2 teams from each division based on total points (8 teams) and 2 Wild Card teams will advance to the playoffs (Playoff dates and courses TBD.) Playoffs are single elimination format, teams seeded 1-8 based on points, seeds 9 & 10 are wildcards.
- d. Play for each week can be completed within a 2-week timeframe from Monday-Sunday, with teams being responsible for scheduling their tee times. Teams **DO NOT** have to play against each other, can play at different times.
- e. If a team or team member cannot complete their round/s before the Sunday bi-weekly deadline, the opposing team or team member will play against a “GHOST” team/player of similar handicap for a chance to still earn points. **PLEASE NOTE: We will allow teams to play ahead if needed.**
- f. We have the discretion to award more time to complete rounds based on individual needs (i.e., medical emergencies, family emergencies, etc.)
- g. Subs will be allowed and encouraged if you’re unsure that you will not be able make it in to play, however we must be contacted prior to their round with your subs name. Subs will start out playing as a 0 handicap (if multiple rounds are played, handicap will form for them) **PLEASE NOTE: Subs earn points toward your teams’ total points, GHOSTS DO NOT**

3) **PLAY RULES**

- a. Slow green speeds, moderate green conditions, firm ground firmness
- b. White Tees or Tee anywhere around 6,000-6,300 yds
- c. Double par + 1 will be the max stroke limit per hole (i.e. 7 on Par 3’s, 9 on Par 4’s, 11 on Par 5’s). If you get past double par, concede the hole on the system.
- d. 9 ft gimmies (ball must finish INSIDE 9 ft in order to be deemed a gimmie)
- e. No lie penalties
